 - The LEOSA Reform Act passed in the US House of Representatives.
 - This act updates and clarifies some rules and restrictions for carrying firearms by qualified active and retired Law Enforcement officers in areas such as school zones, federal buildings, National Parks and addresses magazine capacity. Updates to follow
